 - A. _____ thought he was inadequate for the task God sent him to do, due to the uncertainties that surrounded the task. (*Ex. 3:11, 13; 4:1, 10, 13*) And he was inadequate!
 - B. The _____ (Pharaoh) thought Moses was inadequate for the task God sent him to do (*Ex.7:2,13-14, 22; 8:19, 32; 9:7, 12, 34-35*) And he was inadequate!
 - C. Those Moses _____ thought he was inadequate for the task God sent him to do (*Ex.5:21; 6:9*). And he was inadequate!
 - D. God alone is more than capable! But God chooses to use _____ who will tell those in bondage what God can and will do for them (*Ex.6:1-8*)

3. **God uses people who are _____ what God said he would do and what He wants them to do.** (*Exodus 4:22-23; 5:1, 7:6-7, 17; 8:1, 8:20*)
