James 4:1-5 Where do wars and fights come from among you? Do they not come from your desires for pleasure that war in your members? (2) You lust and do not have. You murder and covet and cannot obtain. You fight and war. Yet you do not have because you do not ask. (3) You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend it on your pleasures. (4) Adulterers and adulteresses! Do you not know that friendship with the world is enmity with God? Whoever therefore wants to be a friend of the world makes himself an enemy of God. (5) Or do you think that the Scripture says in vain, "The Spirit who dwells in us yearns jealously"?

1. The SOURCE of Conflicts and Strife (vs 1)

**争战斗殴的<u>源头</u>** (vs 1) Pleasure – hedonism – to satisfy self – personal goals before God's Will 寻欢作乐—享乐主义 — 满足自我 — 个人目标高于神的旨意

2. **The <u>CAUSE</u> of Unanswered Prayer** (vs 2, 3, Luke 22:42, 1 John 5:14-15) 求也得不着的原因 (vs 2, 3, 路 22:42, 约一 5:14-15) Lust – to desire strongly – any intense longing – an inner attitude 妄求—强烈的欲望 — 任何激烈的欲望 — 个内在的态度

3. **An <u>ENEMY</u> or a <u>FRIEND</u> of God** (vs 4, Jeremiah 3:1-5, 8, 13, Hosea 1:2, Ezekiel 23, James 4:5)

**与神为<u>敌</u>还是与神为<u>友</u>** (vs 4, 耶 3:1-5, 8, 13, 何 1:2, 结 23, 雅 4:5)
Friendship with the world – a deliberate choice to follow the way of the world.
与世俗为友的 — 故意选择跟从世俗的道路

Let's analyze our prayers. If they are usually for our own convenience, comfort or pleasure, it's time to change our praying. Prayer isn't a time to give orders but to report for duty.
