WHY IS JESUS WORTHY?



1 – Because Jesus took away our sin and rose again. Consider Christ's Sacrifice as the Payment for YOUR Sin.

“Now this is the testimony of John, when the Jews sent priests and Levites from Jerusalem to ask him, “Who are you?” He confessed, and did not deny, but confessed, “I am not the Christ.” And they asked him, “What then? Are you Elijah?” He said, “I am not.” “Are you the Prophet?” And he answered, “No.”

WHO JESUS IS



“ But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot”

WHO JESUS IS



“Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.”

WHO JESUS IS



“ So Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.”

WHO JESUS IS



“ Whom God set forth *as* a propitiation by His blood, through faith, to demonstrate His righteousness, because in His forbearance God had passed over the sins that were previously committed”

WHO JESUS IS



“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

WHO JESUS IS



“I have been crucified with Christ; it is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the *life* which I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.”

WHAT HE DID



“ Now on the first *day* of the week Mary Magdalene went to the tomb early, while it was still dark, and saw *that* the stone had been taken away from the tomb”

“Then she ran and came to Simon Peter, and to the other disciple, whom Jesus loved, and said to them, “They have taken away the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid Him.”

WHAT HE DID



“Then they said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping?” She said to them, “Because they have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid Him.”

WHAT HE DID



“ Jesus said to her, “Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?”
She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, “Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away.”

“ And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses”

“ In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace”

“each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.
