

Matthew 6:24,25 "No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other, you cannot serve God and Mammon, ²⁵Therefore I say to you, do not worry about your life...." (Daniel 1:1, 2; 2:1-3)

Desires of Nebuchadnezzar's Heart that Contributed to His Battle of Anxiety, Stress, Depression:

1. His anxiety battle was rooted in a WAR FOR POWER

- A. It places me squarely ABOVE GOD
- B. It gives me the ILLUSION OF CONTROL
- C. It causes me to $\ \underline{SUBSTITUTE\ WORSHIP}$ for wealth or sin.

2. His anxiety battle looked for Relief FROM PEOPLE (Daniel 2:1-3)

(Daniel 2:1-3)

- A. People cannot <u>BRING RELIEF</u> to your troubled spirit.
- B. People cannot <u>UNDERSTAND</u> the depth of your trouble the way God can.
- C. People with anxiety $\underline{CANNOT HELP}$ people with anxiety.

3. His anxiety battle was <u>RULED BY PRIDE</u> (Dan 3:1)

- A. Pride tells me that I need to be THE MOST IMPORTANT
- B. Pride only gets relief when I am <u>CELEBRATED AS KING</u> (vs 3:2-5)
- C. Pride <u>PUNISHES OTHERS</u> when it is neglected or does not get its way (vs 3:6)
- 4. He allowed anxiety to <u>RUIN HIS PRIVILEGE</u> (vs 4:28-33)
 - A. His privilege of kingship was replaced by <u>SEVEN YEARS OF</u> <u>SUFFERING</u>
 - B. His life of ruins was God's way to GET HIS ATTENTION
 - C. His depression had a spiritual answer serve the <u>ONE MASTER</u> (vs 4:3, 4:34)
