

James 5:1-6 "Come now, you rich, weep and howl for your miseries that are coming upon you! <sup>2</sup>Your riches are corrupted, and your garments are motheaten. <sup>3</sup>Your gold and silver are corroded, and their corrosion will be a witness against you and will eat your flesh like fire. You have heaped up treasure in the last days. <sup>4</sup>Indeed the wages of the labourers who mowed your fields, which you kept back by fraud, cry out; and the cries of the reapers have reached the ears of the Lord of Sabaoth. <sup>5</sup>You have lived on the earth in pleasure and luxury; you have fattened your hearts as in a day of slaughter. <sup>6</sup>You have condemned, you have murdered the just; he does not resist you."
