## What's Your Motive?

## 2 Corinthians - Part 9 (2 Cor. 5:11-21)

Why do we do it (our ministries)? Examine your motives:

1. The FEAR OF THE LORD (vs 11)
A. Our GOAL (2 Corinthians 5:9, Galatians 1:10)
B. Our REMINDER (2 Corinthians 5:10)
C. Our LABOUR (5:11-13, 1 Peter 4:18)
2. The LOVE OF CHRIST (vs 14, Romans 5:6-8, Psalm 2:11)
D. We DIED WITH HIM (vs 5:14, Romans 6:1-3, Galatians 2:20)
E. We ROSE WITH HIM (vs 15-17)
3. Christ's COMMISSION (vs 18-21)
"Knowing, therefore, the terror of the Lord, we persuade men; but we are well known to God, and I also trust are well known in your consciences. ${ }^{12}$ For we do not commend ourselves again to you, but give you opportunity to boast on our behalf, that you may have an answer for those who boast in appearance and not in heart. ${ }^{13}$ For if we are beside ourselves, it is for God; or if we are of sound mind, it is for you. ${ }^{14}$ For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; ${ }^{15}$ and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them
and rose again.
${ }^{16}$ Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. ${ }^{17}$ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. ${ }^{18}$ Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to

Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, ${ }^{19}$ that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation.
${ }^{20}$ Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God. ${ }^{21}$ For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him."
